



Class Act of Carlsbad – Instructions for Parents

Your senior and a guest (no one younger than this year’s sophomore) are cordially invited to attend the Class Act senior party to be held one hour after graduation until 5:00am the next day at the Pecos River Village Convention Center (711 Muscatel Avenue; across from the Elk’s Lodge). This is Carlsbad’s way of honoring our seniors for their outstanding achievements during their high school years.

Those seniors who will NOT be graduating (provided they are still enrolled and attending) and those who graduated mid-year are invited to attend. Because no one will be admitted as a senior whose name does not appear on the senior rolls supplied us by each school. Seniors who think that their name might not be included, must contact the school and have the dean/counselor call to confirm their status to Class Act (575) 885-3142.

The all-night affair will include music and special effects provided by a professional Disc Jockey, cash giveaways, dance contests with prizes, final draw for great prizes, \$1,000-academic scholarships, various games and recreational events, lots of food, and a sunrise continental breakfast ending at 5:00am.

NO STUDENTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER AFTER 11:00PM OR 1 HOUR AFTER GRADUATION, WHICHEVER COMES LAST.

RULES

The Senior Class said, “No Drinking! No Drugs! No Fighting!”

- 1. Carlsbad Police will guard vehicles all night long. Anyone with alcohol or if alcohol is detected in any vehicle, the person(s) will be arrested. No exceptions!
- 2. No food and only bottled water may be taken inside the dance hall, casino, or convention center
- 3. To be eligible for prizes, students must stay the entire night...and there are LOTS of prizes
- 4. Courtesy / Security Room - This is a room located across from the Casino where you may check in and out your personal things for safekeeping. (i.e. purses, yearbooks, cell phones, bingo prizes, etc.).
- 5. Seniors MUST sign in by 11:00pm or 1 hour after graduation, whichever comes later
- 6. Only Class Act Board chaperones after 5:00pm Friday
 Parents are welcome to walk-thru on Thursday or Friday during the day

- 1. Comfortable / casual: shorts, slacks, t-shirts, tops, etc.
- 2. Comfortable footwear
- 3. It is suggested everyone bring a light jacket or sweater because the Carousel House gets very cool in the early morning hours
- 4. No bathing attire
